GOAL: To decrease incidents of violence and alcohol/drug abuse by 2-5%.

1. What needs to be improved? Description of area of need	Decrease the number and frequency of risk behaviors of students. Increase the knowledge base of students and staff in the area of school safety and alcohol and drug-free.
2. What were the specific sources of evidence you used to determine the need? Name of specific data source/s used to determine the basis of the modification/improvement/change	Student alcohol, drug, smoking, violence data. Adolescent Behavior Health Risk Survey data. Title I student/parent survey data. Annual Pride survey.
3. How was the data analyzed & who did the analysis? Describe how the analysis of data was done and who was involved in the analysis	The data was analyzed by looking at cross-sectional and trend data.
4. What did you find? Statement of findings	The number of discipline incidents over time has increased, the number of violence (fighting) related incidences has decreased for some areas, but safety is still a student concern and a priority of the school.
5. What are you going to do about it? Proposed modification/improvement/change based on Scientifically Based Research.	Continue to implement the various curriculums utilized by each area counselor. Research additional effective programs and recommend for adoption. Educate the staff and all students. Implement the Student Assistance Program for High School.
6. How do you plan to accomplish that? Description of plan to implement the proposed modification/improvement/change	Implement the Staff Development Plan for Safe and Drug Free Schools. Coordinate Alcohol and Drug Free Activities (Red Ribbon Week, etc) and reward students with incentives.
7. How will you know if your plan made a difference? Describe the evidence of change you hope will result from your efforts	Show a decrease in the annual total student incidences of alcohol, drug, and violence and a decrease in student risk behaviors as shown on the adolescent behavior health risk survey.
8. What resources are needed to implement the plan? Describe the resources implication for this plan	Staff will be necessary to implement the plan which will include 6 counselors, 6 principals, 2 safety officers, 1 dean of students, and 2 additional staff members.
