Where did you go to school? Eagle Butte

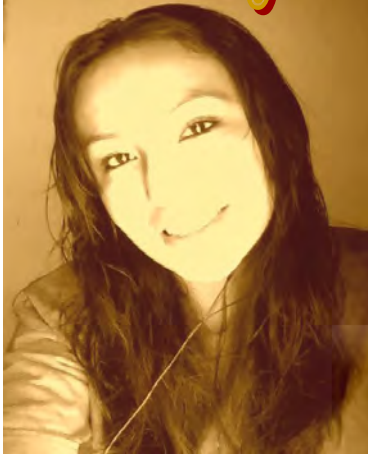
How has the school changed since you were in school? We had shorter classes and longer lunch hours.

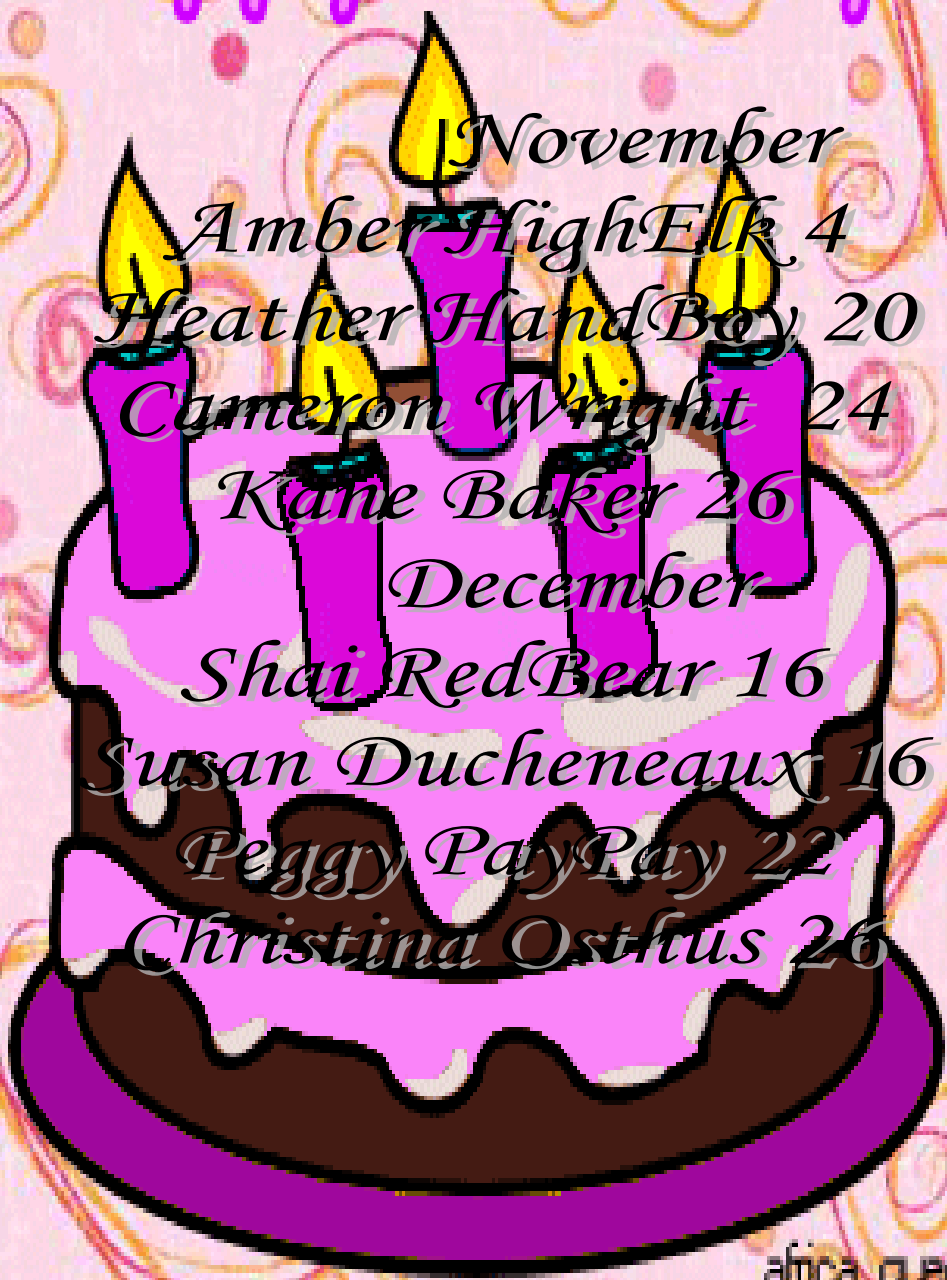

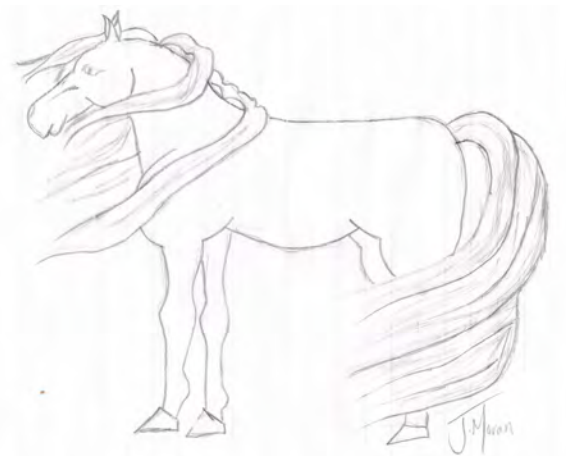
EC II students aren't the only artistic ones around here—the EC I students got pretty creative around Halloween!

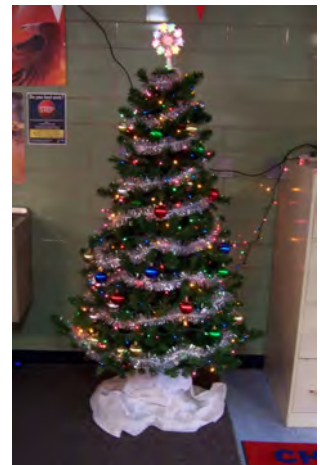
